



Gosport Marine Futures: Sailing Bursary Scheme 2019

Gosport Marine Futures is an adventurous Sail Training and personal development programme for 14-17 year olds living in the Gosport and Portsmouth Harbour area. Through taking part in a week long voyage on board a 50 foot yacht you will discover hidden strengths and talents, make new friends and find out about your coast. After your voyage, there will be opportunities to take part in vessel maintenance, learn about jobs available in the maritime sector, or get involved with a local sailing club. You may even gain a recognised RYA sailing qualification.

2 week long voyages are available, for 8 people each. The experience is funded by Gosport Marine Scene (now part of Portsmouth Harbour Marine) whose aim is to get more local young people involved in the Marine Sector. No previous sailing experience is required as you will be taught everything you need to know. You just need to have an interest in the outdoors and be willing to give it your best.

To take part, you must be between 14 and 17 years old and available from 27th July to 2nd August 2019 (Week 1), or from the 15th to 21st August 2019 (Week 2).
